Legacy data centres are inefficient and use a lot of power; someone has to pay for that power and ultimately, that someone was us."

After viewing a number of leading data centres, it was apparent that most legacy facilities, though appearing modern, have a design flaw in their 'open' architecture. These big rooms are inefficient and expensive to cool, which create unnecessary costs which are passed on to their customers. As Michael observed, data centres require large capital investments which take several decades to achieve a return and it's financially impossible for most providers to make the investment in more power-efficient facilities.

Other areas of concern for Seccom were the standard of infrastructure available and whether their new data centre could scale with future growth. After careful consideration, it became clear that Nextgen offered the only data centres that met their requirements. Michael explains some of the key factors in their decision:
